



# Golden Delicious Reinders



## Hardly any russetting

The fruit is hardly susceptible to russetting. Suitable for growing in less favourable cultivation areas. The skin is very smooth and the fruit has a very nice shape. The apple's flesh is yellowish, firm, crunchy and sweet, and it has a very low acid content. The harvest must take place at the right time.

### Origin

Golden Delicious mutation, found by Reinders (The Netherlands)

### Tree

Medium growth, open side branch angle, medium to late bloom, good pollinator

Pollinators: Jonathan, Granny Smith, Gala, Red Delicious, Crimson Gold, Evereste

### Harvest

Beginning to middle of September, easy to store
