



Golden Parsi da rosa



Little russetting and high yield

Can compete with Golden Reinders in terms of russetting but retains the properties of Clone B. In higher locations, part of the fruit obtains a red colour which remains red after months of storage. The shape of the apple is high, with characteristic bumps at the top.

Tree

Medium growth, easy to differentiate from other Golden apples based on its dark wood, medium to late bloom

Pollinators: Jonathan, Granny Smith, Gala, Red Delicious, Crimson Gold, Evereste

Harvest

Beginning to middle of September (like Golden Delicious Clone B)
